

# Cézanne Challenge GUIDELINES

## Submitting Your Students' *Cézanne Challenge* Artwork Online

1. Submission of student work is considered permission to post online.
2. The BMA will select images of student artwork that best carry out the purposes and activities of the *Cézanne Challenge*. The content of each artwork must be appropriate for classroom viewing.
3. Selected images will be posted by the BMA at <http://www.flickr.com/photos/artbma> . Teachers will be notified if their student's work is posted.
4. Images will remain online at the discretion of the BMA.
5. Teachers may request removal of any of their own student's work. Contact [Landre@artbma.org](mailto:Landre@artbma.org)
6. Teachers should send student work in **jpg format**, preferably 1600 pixels on the longest side at 72 ppi (resolution).
7. Please include the following information for each picture:
  - Date of submission
  - Teacher's name
  - Name of school
  - County of school
  - Teacher's phone number
  - Teacher's e-mail address
  - First name of student, student's grade, student's school (for example, Bobby, grade 7, Highland Middle School)
  - Student-written title of picture and caption (no more than 20 words) describing what the student tried to do in making this picture.
  - Please indicate which side of the picture is "up" if it is at all unclear.
  - Please include a brief teacher statement (a few sentences) explaining the gist of the lesson.
