EXHIBITION: Andy Warhol: The Last Decade

DATES: October 17, 2010 – January 9, 2011

OVERVIEW: This awe-inspiring exhibition explores the late work of influential artist and international celebrity Andy Warhol. See the Pop Art icon as never before through more than 50 paintings, including psychologically revealing self portraits, monumental variations of Leonardo da Vinci’s *The Last Supper*, and collaborations with younger artists like Jean-Michel Basquiat. These works, many of them not exhibited until after his death, demonstrate Warhol’s renewed spirit of experimentation during the 70s and 80s.

Andy Warhol: The Last Decade is a special ticketed exhibition with a complimentary audio tour.
