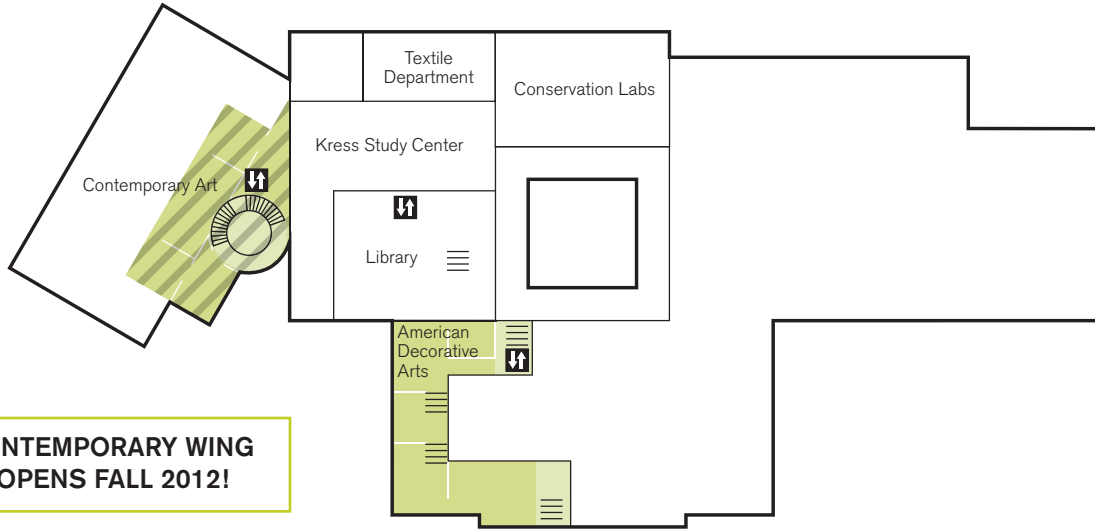

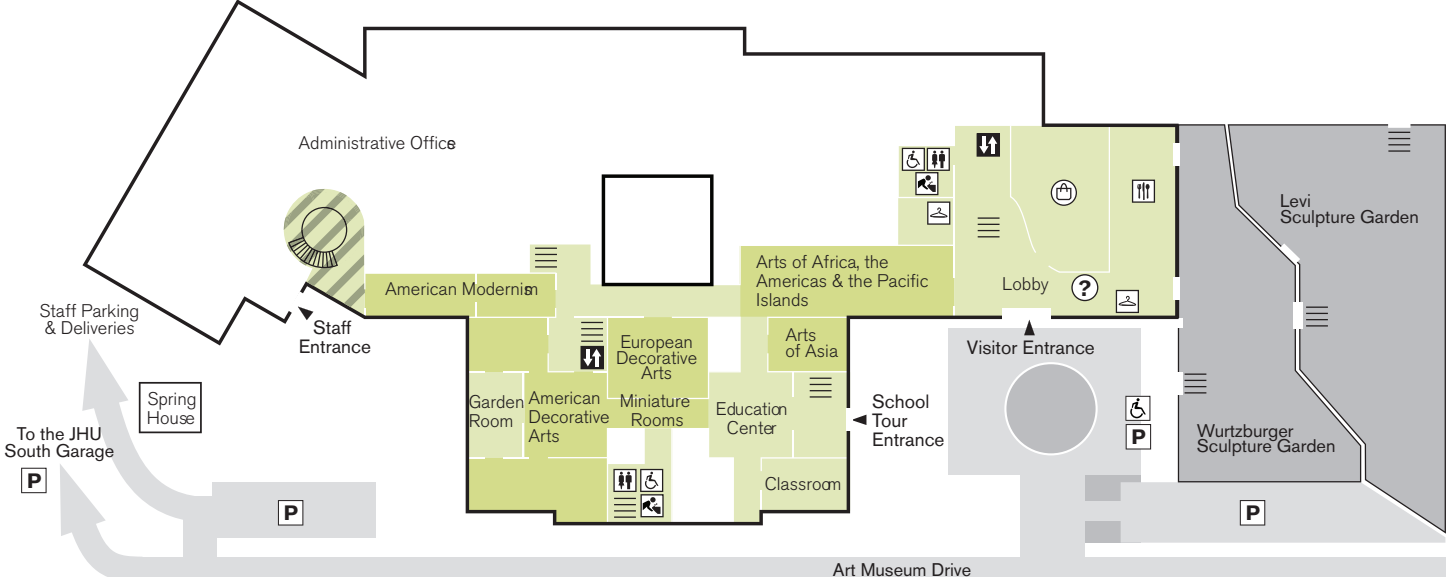

VISITOR TIPS

Whether you are a first-time visitor or a lifelong BMA Member, we ask for your help in maintaining a safe environment for visitors and works of art. **Thank you!**

Please...

Help us preserve the art for future generations. **Please do not touch** the works of art. Oils and moisture from hands can cause damage, even to sculptures that are outside.

Lockers are provided free of charge to store over-size items. Please place all packages, umbrellas, backpacks (including baby backpack carriers), and bags or items larger than 11 x 15 inches at the **free Coat Check** in the Lobby.

Keep **food and drinks** out of the galleries and Auditorium.

Use **cell phones** only in Lobby areas, and in the Sculpture Gardens.

The Museum and Sculpture Gardens are smoke-free environments. **Thank you for not smoking.**

Photography & Videotaping—Photography for personal use is welcome in collection galleries and Sculpture Gardens during public hours—without flash, lights, or a tripod—provided it does not endanger works of art or interfere with the viewing experience of others. Photographs may not be reproduced, distributed, or sold without permission from the BMA. Art in temporary exhibitions and on loan may not be photographed. Videotaping is not permitted in the galleries.

Sketching is welcome in the galleries with pencil only. Copyists working with wet media must obtain advanced permission by calling 443-573-1730.

Strollers and Baby Changing—Strollers are welcome but may be restricted during peak times. (Baby backpack carriers and diaper bags must be checked at our free Coat Check.) A baby changing station is available in the Lobby restroom.

Sculpture Gardens are outdoor gallery spaces. Please stay on paved paths and refrain from touching works of art and plantings. For your safety and the safety of others, pets, bicycles, scooters, skates, skateboards, glass containers, and alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the gardens.

ACCESSIBILITY

Wheelchairs—A limited number of wheelchairs are available for use free of charge. Please check in at our Welcome Desk in the Lobby upon arrival.

Wheelchair Accessibility—The Museum and tiered sculpture gardens are wheelchair accessible. Wheelchair accessible restrooms are located on the 1st Floor.

Service Animals—Service animals are welcome in the Museum. Please check in at our Welcome Desk in the Lobby upon arrival.

Assisted Listening Devices—A limited number of assisted listening devices are available for use free of charge for programs in the BMA's Meyerhoff Auditorium.

Special Needs—Tours for visitors who are blind or have low vision, sign language interpreted tours, and selected foreign language tours are available upon request with a minimum of 2 weeks' notice. Please call 443-573-1825 for details.
